144 APPEAL PROCESS

ALAPIFAL DROSONS ARE HIVAL AND INCONIESTABLE

- A Asturbet who has lost eligibility due to failure to make SAP or by exceeding line frame may file a Birancial Aid Appeal. Submission of an appeal does NOT CLARANTEE the reinstatement of firencial aid.
 - Granstances related to an outbreak of COVID 19 including but not limited to the illness of a student or family member; compliance with a quantine period, or the general disruption resulting from such an outbreak qualify as externating circumstances for the Firancial Aid Appeal process.
 - 2 Students should be prepared to pay for their bods and others chool related expenses per ding the outcome of their appeal.

1. Classrepeats may be included when determining the student's emollment for Financial Aid as long as the repeat is NOT a result of:



- A Napa Valley College implemented a COVID 19 Excused With classed (EW) grade and a COVID 19 drop reason code to identify students who with the wition classes due to COVID 19 related reasons.
 - a BeginningSpring2023 classes dropped with an 'EW' grade are not automatically excluded from attempted credits when the SAP calculation is run each senester. Students who receive an 'EW' grade due to COVID 19 must submit a written request to exclude the 'EW' grade along with a copy of their approved Late Add/Dopand Waiver of College Regulations Retition
 - b BeginningSpring2023 classes dropped with a COVID 19 drop status (but not an 'EW grade) are manually reviewed and excluded from attempted credits after the SAP calculation is run each senester. Sturberts who receive a COVID 19 drop status must submit a written request to exclude the course along with a copy of their approved Late Add/Drop and Waiver of College Regulations Retition
- B OnMach 13, 2020) the Resident of the United States declared a COMD 19 partenic rational energy resulting in the temporary caseation of operations and interruption of instruction at Napa Valley College. Due to that interruption, all Spring 2020 students were determined to have been affected by COMD 19 and given an "EW" grade if they dropped accurse during the affected period. Affected drops that did not qualify for an "EW" grade (due to registration rules) were reviewed and excluded manually after the senester SAPC alculation was not
- C BeginningSunner 2020) students who drop for COVID 19 related reasons may submit a petition to Admissions & Records requesting an Excused With classed (EW). If the petition is approved
 - a An EW gade is entered if the student dropped for COVID 19 related reasons during the time frame allowed to dropped associations with a "W" gade
 - b ACMD 19 drop status code is entered if the sturbut dropped cutside the time frame allowed to drop a draw with a "W" garde.
- D Students affected by COVID 19 circumstances who fail to neet the FASAP criteria and lose financial aid eligibility may submit a Financial Aid Appeal. See section 14.4 Appeal Process for more information
