Transfer courses must be equivalent to Napa courses unless they are on the IGETC list at the campus where completed. Students are expected to complete all of the requirements (a total of 39-42 semester units) before transferring to a UC or CSU campus. If a student, for good cause, is unable to complete one or two IGETC courses he/she may be eligible to complete the IGETC pattern after transferring. Students should consult with a counselor for details regarding this option.
