## Napa Valley College Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) Effective Fall 2009 Through Summer 2010

Completion of all the requirements in the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) will permit you to transfer from a community college to a campus in either the California State University (CSU) or the University of California (UC) system without the need, after transfer, to take additional lower-division, general education courses to satisfy campusll courses MUST be completed with grades of "C" or better. Please consult with a counselor or the transcript evaluator regarding the use of courses from other colleges or universities. Students who choose to use the IGETC pattern are expected to complete all of the requirements of the pattern before transferring to a UC or CSU campus. However, if a student is unable to complete one or two IGETC courses he/she

 $\underline{\text{may}}$  be eligible for partial certification. Students should consult with a counselor for details regarding this option.

Restrictions: Student who have been registered at a UC campus <u>may not</u> be eligible for IGETC. Students should consult with a counselor regarding this issue. This restriction, though, does not apply to students who have taken only UC summer session or Extension classes.
